Visualizing Pipeline Impacts will support the documentation and public dissemination of two collaborating faculty research projects that mobilize communitybased action against gas pipeline impacts within the Tri-State area. These are two multimedia initiatives in partnership with the non-profit Delaware Riverkeeper Network designed for communities within rural/environmental justice zones.
