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## El Tema: A Youtube Documentary on Climate Change

Bernal produced a six part documentary series centered around the climate crisis in Mexico. The

## series is called *'El Tem*a' which translates to *'The Theme'*.



Each episode is based on a theme that is at the center of the climate crisis in Mexico. These themes are explored through the lived experience of the communities, human right activists, and climate defenders from across the country battling against big corporations to restore equilibrium in the environment.

The first episode, titled 'Agua' (Spanish for 'water') begins with the following, "It all starts with Aqua, even here, where it seems the earth has forgotten it... As a species we try our luck at the expense of all others. Today, territory and water are forcing us to stop. To submerge in the hope that another way of understanding life is possible". The

air, mining, energy, food, and ocean.
